

REFUND POLICY

Below is the refund policy for SCIS Summer Kids Camp 2017:

1. Following the final pay due date (May 31, 2017) there will be no refunds for transportation fees.
2. Following the final pay due date (May 31, 2017) there will be no refund for tuition fees paid for any reason, beyond matters of policy dealing with Government intervention (e.g. H7N9 outbreak and quarantine is imposed, thus the child cannot attend). In such cases the school is likely to offer a partial refund on tuition fees on a case-by-case basis.
3. In the case of enrollment cancelation for illness or other reasons, pro-rated refunds with a minimum charge of 1 day/per each week canceled will be offered.
 - a. There will be no refunds for transportation fees in any cases.
 - b. Families who cancel before attending will be refunded full tuition minus a 1-day (20%) cancelation charge per each week canceled.
 - c. Families who cancel mid-week will be refunded pro-rated tuition (based on number of days attended, including partial days) minus a 1-day (20%) cancelation charge per each week canceled.
 - d. There will be no refunds given for one-week sessions that are not fully cancelled.
4. All refunds will only be handled by finance following the last day of Summer Kids Camp.
5. Following the final pay due date (May 31, 2017), SCIS holds all power to either award or deny refunds for any reason
